“Pittsgrove Township Enforcing Chapter 71 the “Numbering of Buildings” Ordinance”

The Pittsgrove Township Committee’s Public Safety Standing Committee wishes to remind residents that the Chapter 71, “Numbering of Buildings” Ordinance will be aggressively enforced. This is also known as the “911 Post” Ordinance. *It is imperative from a safety standpoint that this is strictly adhered to by everyone!*

The entire Ordinance can be found on our Township website (www.pittsgrovetownship.com), but the important sections of Chapter 71 (71 – 1 through 71 – 9) are:

“...the post is to stand alone (should be free of mailboxes and other attachments) of treated wood or metal,shall measure 4’x4’x6’ with at least 48” above ground ...with 3 1/2” **reflective** numbers on two sides andis to be located on the **house side** of the driveway”.

Violators, could, as a last resource, receive a sentence of imprisonment in the County jail, a fine and/or community service.

We really want to make sure our emergency personnel are able to find your residence as quickly as possible, *when seconds count!!*

Take a moment and check your 911 post! Does it fit the criteria?
