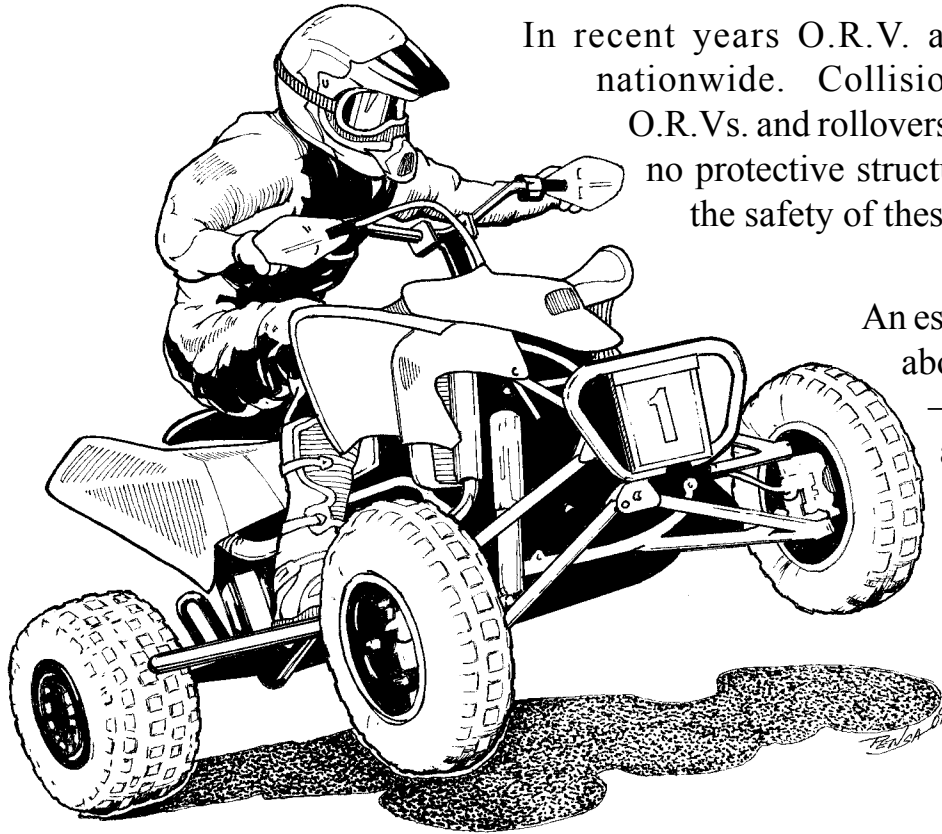

# ATV OWNERS

Over the years Pittsgrove Township residents have increasingly complained of O.R.V. (Off Road Vehicle) trespass. In addition, complaints of noise, crop damage and destruction of natural, conservation lands and forests have been reported to the New Jersey State Police, Nature Conservancy and New Jersey Fish and Game officials.



In recent years O.R.V. accident reports have risen nationwide. Collisions with automobiles, other O.R.Vs. and rollovers while riding on a vehicle with no protective structure have led to concern about the safety of these types of vehicles.

An estimated 700 people – including about 200 children under age 16 – are killed every year in ATV accidents, according to the Consumer Product Safety Commission. An additional 135,000 people — more than a quarter of them children — are treated in emergency rooms for ATV-related injuries.

Pittsgrove Township ordinance 96-24 prohibits the use of any O.R.V. on any land not owned by the rider of an O.R.V. without the expressed written permission of the land owner.

Simply put, riding an Off Road Vehicle on another persons property, township, county or state roads or property is forbidden by law.
