



## PITTSBORO RECYCLABLES INFORMATION

ALL RESIDENTS/PROPERTY OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLIANCE WITH MANDATORY RECYCLING PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS.

### MANDATORY RECYCLABLES:

The following materials must be disposed of as recyclable materials, rather than waste, and shall be disposed of in designated containers.

- A. COMINGLE: (PUT THE FOLLOWING RECYCLABLES TOGETHER IN ONE CONTAINER)  
PLASTIC BOTTLES, GLASS BOTTLES (ALL COLORS), STEEL, TIN AND ALUMINUM CANS  
All glass and plastic containers shall be rinsed and have caps, rings or bands removed prior to disposal.  
All steel, tin and aluminum cans used to store food or beverages shall be rinsed to remove food residue.
- B. CORRUGATED (CARDBOARD): Clean corrugated or cardboard containers used for food boxes or to transport supplies, equipment or parts. Includes brown paper bags.
- C. PAPER: Newspapers and inserts, magazines, office paper, copier paper, computer paper, books and junk mail.
- D. SCRAP METAL: Tire rims, springs, bicycles and like goods.  
Excluded: Propane tanks, gasoline fuel tanks or gasoline containers/cans, fuel tanks from kerosene heaters and oil filled radiator type heaters.

### ADDITIONAL RECYCLABLE MATERIALS:

- A. BATTERIES, LEAD ACID: Batteries from automobiles, trucks or other vehicles, machinery and equipment.
- B. BATTERIES, HOUSEHOLD: Common household batteries such as AA, C and D cell. All rechargeable type batteries such as NiCd, NiMH, and Lithium Ion batteries.
- C. BRUSH/TREE PARTS: Branches and wood chips from residential sources.  
Excluded: Brush from clearing operations and tree limbs in excess of three (3) inches in diameter and eight (8) feet long.
- D. CONCRETE: Concrete, cement and cinderblock. Limited to one (1) pick-up truckload, up to 500 lbs/2 cubic yards, per homeowner project.
- E. GRASS CLIPPINGS: Grass clippings from mowing lawns.
- F. LEAVES: Tree leaves only. Excluded: Grass clippings and brush.  
Residents/property owners/occupants are encouraged to mulch or compost leaves at their sites.
- F. TIRES: Rubber based automotive, truck or specialty tires. There is a disposal fee for all tires.
- G. USED MOTOR OIL: Petroleum based or synthetic based oils. Containers of five (5) gallons or less are recommended for ease of handling. Used motor oils shall be protected from contamination by rainwater.
- H. WHITE GOODS: Products such as washers, dryers, gas and electric ranges, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, hot water heaters and similar appliances. There is a disposal fee for all refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners.
- I. COMPUTER MONITORS: There is a disposal fee for all computer monitors.
- J. PROPANE TANKS: There is a disposal fee for all propane tanks.

**PROHIBITED MATERIALS:**

The Pittsgrove Township Waste Disposal Facility Attendant is authorized to reject any item consisting of or containing these materials:

- A. Animal carcasses.
- B. Automobiles, tractors, farm machinery, trailers and trucks or parts of any of these vehicles.
- C. Herbicide, pesticide and chemical containers, unless triple rinsed and certified to be non- hazardous.
- D. Non-household chemical or petroleum products.
- E. Gasoline fuel tanks, gasoline containers/cans, kerosene heaters, fuel tanks and oil filled radiator type heaters.
- F. Tree stumps.
- G. Oil based paints.
- H. Waste materials resulting from construction, repair, alteration, renovation or demolition by contractors and residents/property owners.
- I. Waste materials generated outside of the Township.

All vehicles must display a Resident Vehicle Waste Permit which may be obtained from the Pittsgrove Township Public Works Department at the Pittsgrove Township Municipal Annex/Garage, 1004 Centerton Road, Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.
