PUBLIC NOTICE
BOND ORDINANCE STATEMENTS AND SUMMARY

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by Township Committee of the Township of Pittsgrove, in the County of Salem, State of New Jersey on September 25, 2019 and the twenty (20) day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. Copies of the full ordinance are available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Clerk's office for members of the general public who request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS 2019 GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS, BY AND IN THE TOWNSHIP OF PITTSBORO, IN THE COUNTY OF SALEM, STATE OF NEW JERSEY; APPROPRIATING \$606,400 THEREFOR (INCLUDING A GRANT EXPECTED TO BE RECEIVED FROM THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION) AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$200,000 BONDS OR NOTES TO FINANCE PART OF THE COST THEREOF

Purpose(s): Various 2019 General Capital Improvements, Including, But Not Limited To, Roadway Improvements Including, But Not Limited To, Morton Avenue, Cleveland Avenue, Creamer Drive, English Road, Erwina Street, Forrest Road, Harrison Street, Isaacs Avenue, Middle Drive, Parkside Drive, Peach Street, Wallace Street And Washington Street, Various Facility Improvements And Acquisitions For Municipal Building And Greenbranch Park; And Various Acquisitions And Installations Of Equipment For The Department Of Public Works

Appropriation: \$606,400

Bonds/Notes Authorized: \$200,000

Grant(s) Appropriated: \$200,000 Grant From The New Jersey Department Of Transportation

Section 20 Costs: \$100,000

Useful Life: 20 years
