ORDINANCE NO. 2020-01

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING CHAPTER 83. SOLID WASTE, PART 1. WASTE MANAGEMENT, ARTICLE VI. PROPER HANDLING OF YARD WASTE

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Pittsgrove, County of Salem and State of New Jersey as follows:

Modification of Section 83.31. Yard waste collection

Section 83.31 is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

“The Township does not collect yard waste and does not have a composting facility and as such, residents are encouraged to compost onsite or dispose of their own yard waste. The owner or occupant of any property, or any employee or contractor of such owner or occupant engaged to provide lawn care or landscaping services, shall not sweep, rake, blow or otherwise place yard waste that is not containerized at the curb or along the street or is placed closer than 10 feet from any storm drain inlet. Yard waste must be containerized and placed at the curb or street for your normal private trash collection day. If loose yard waste is placed at the curb, the party responsible for placement of the yard waste must remove the yard waste from the curb or street or said party shall be deemed in violation of this Ordinance.”


Section One. Repealer. All former Ordinances of the Township of Pittsgrove which are in conflict with the provisions contained in this Ordinance are hereby repealed upon the adoption of this Ordinance.

Section Two. Severability. If any part or parts of this Ordinance are held to be invalid for any reason such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section Three. This Ordinance shall take effect after final approval and publication as required by law.
